A will is perhaps the most important document you can have, although surprisingly more than half of all Americans die without one. A will is critical to making sure your wishes for the people and organizations are carried out exactly as you wish.

When you create your bequest, here are three facts your attorney will need:

- Our Federal Tax Identification Number: 84-1150042

It's easy to make a bequest to Habitat. Here are examples of the most common types of bequests. Be sure to discuss them with your attorney as you prepare or update your will.

- **A specific bequest:** a gift of a specific item.
- **A general bequest:** usually a gift of a certain amount of money.
- **A residuary bequest:** a gift for the "rest, residue and remainder" (or what's left) of your estate after all other bequests, debts and taxes have been paid.

Designating Blue Spruce Habitat in your will means your gift will remain in our mountain community and give you a lasting legacy.
